> I'm doing some research on the history of malware. The word "malware"
> was coined in 1990 by Professor Yisrael Radai.

I know he gets credited with the first public posting using the term, July 4, 1990, but I was using the term in seminars more than a year earlier. My wife always insists that I coined it, although I never asserted any claim, figuring that it was an obvious use. I used it to point out that, unlike the feeling of most users and media reports of the time, there were multiple classes of malware, and not every computer problem was a "virus" :-)
